FAMILY RESOURCE CENTERS POLICIES

1 Dress Code

Purpose: To maintain a welcoming, respectful, and distraction-free environment, all visitors to NOLA Public Schools Family Resource Centers (FRCs) are expected to adhere to a basic dress code.

Scope: This policy applies to all persons entering FRCs, including non-student, non-staff individuals.

General Guidelines:

- Visitors are expected to dress in a manner that is respectful and appropriate
- for the environment.
- Attire should be free from offensive language, images, or logos.
- Clothing must not be transparent or revealing and must cover undergarments.
- Sports bras are considered undergarments.
- Footwear should be worn at all times.
- · Sunglasses, hats and other headwear should be removed upon entering the
- building unless worn for religious or medical reasons.

Visitors not complying with this dress code may be asked to modify their attire or leave the premises.

2 Limited Capacity

Purpose: To ensure confidentiality and maintain a safe, comfortable space for all, we kindly ask that no more than two (2) people per family (including children) sit with a Student Enrollment Coordinator to discuss enrollment or work permits.
