




## VERIFY PARENT/GUARDIAN

When applying for an early childhood program, like preschool or daycare, we need to verify your identity. This also helps to ensure the safety and security of all children involved in the program. Certain forms of identification are deemed acceptable for this purpose. These include a driver's license, state ID, passport, and military ID. Let's explore these different forms of identification.

Type of ID	Description of ID	Sample
<p>Driver's License</p>	<p>A driver's license is a very common form of identification. It includes important details such as the holder's photo, full name, date of birth, and residential address.</p> <p>If you require additional information, please visit this link.</p>	
<p>State ID</p>	<p>Not everyone drives, but every state provides a state ID card for such individuals. This card looks very similar to a driver's license. <p>Passport</p>	<p>A passport is a globally recognized form of identification. Issued by the federal government, a passport includes a picture, full name, and date of birth. <p>Military ID</p>	<p>For parents or guardians who serve or have served in the military, a military ID can be used for verification. This ID includes a photo, full name, and rank.
